model

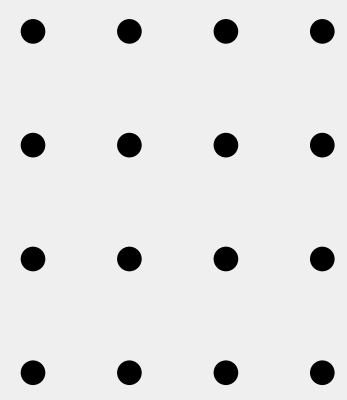
